Haeundae Coastal Train

The romantic retro-style train runs by the Busan Green Railway Trail at a leisurely pace, bringing the mountains and the seas together to create unique scenery. All seats on the train are turned towards the beach, so everyone has a panoramic view of East Busan's sea.

Gamcheon Cultural Village

Dubbed as Korea's Santorini, it provides visual delight to visitors with murals and art installations. This historically rich mountainside slum became a famous tourist destination after getting an arty makeover with clever touches up the stairs, down the lanes and around the corners.

Andong Mask Village

A traditional village established during the Joseon Dynasty, well-known for its thatched-roof and tile-roof houses. It boasts of exquisite scenic sights; the elegant Nakdong River flowing around the village, the magnificent Buyongdae Cliff, sandy beaches and lush, ancient pine trees.

Chungju Lake Cruise

South Korea's largest lake, that was formed after the construction of Chungju Dam. Enjoy a leisure cruise through amazing views of uniquely-shaped rocks and peaks. The lakescape changes colours and ambience at every season but the atmosphere of serenity is the same at all times.
