Purple Island

Banwol Island is identified with its native bellflowers known as Campanula Paint, marked for their lilac colour. Owing to its purple scenery, this unique remote destination is also called Purple Island. Interestingly, it has about 400 houses and buildings with roofs coated in pastel purple colour, including old-school telephone booths and a bridge connecting it to neighbor Bakji Island.

Metasequoia Road

Damyang Metasequoia-lined Road is one of Korea's most beautiful paths. Metasequoia trees were planted along the street. The 8.5 km-long boulevard is one of the most popular driving routes in Korea, especially during summer when the trees' lush green leaves are at their height of beauty.

Jeonju Hanok Village

located in the city of Jeonju and overlaps Pung-dong and Gyo-dong. There are over 800 traditional Korean hanok houses. While the rest of city has been industrialized, Hanok Village retains its historical charms and traditions.

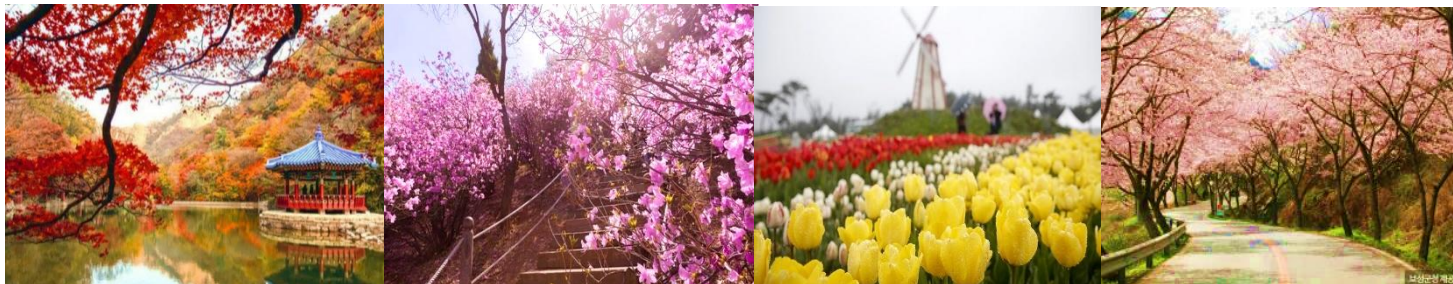
Mokpo Cable Car

On a day with clear sky, why not see the many islands surrounding Mokpo by taking the longest cable ride in Korea. On Yudalsan Mountain, the cable is 3.2 km long over the sea, with 2 stops, observations, and hiking trails. Soar over Mokpo in a red cabin and get a bird's eye view of the port and surrounding islands.

Gwangmyeong Cave

There are many geological feature and thematic areas set up in the Cave. It offers variety experience programs, so the cave is great place to get close to nature. Also, this place become more popular after TV program "Running man" was filmed. It offers visitors a unique opportunity to take part in wine-tasting, with 78 different varieties of quality wine across 8 different Korean vineyards.
