IKAHO ONSEN : Ikaho Onsen is a hot spring town located halfway slopes of Mt Haruna, well known for its "Golden Hotspring" because it becomes reddish brown by oxidized of iron contained in hot water. The atmospheric old town area center around the 365 step long stone stairs which lead up through the middle of town and are lined by Ryokan, traditional shops.



Kiyotsu Gorge Tunnel

It is a beautiful valley that is nationally recognised as one of the Places of Scenic Beauty, and it's also a National Monument. Kiyotsu Gorge has unique blocky cliffs that line the stream that flows through the valley, which makes for a picturesque scene. The valley was formed after a volcano erupted 16 million years ago, and a river slowly eroded the rocks over millenniums.



Fukushimagata Lagoon is a vast nature reserve stretching over 193 hectares. It is home to a number of endangered species of animals and plants and is listed on Japan's 100 greatest natural environments. The park is a paradise for bird and plant lovers.

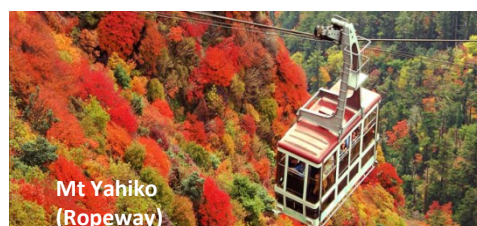
