It's a popular spot for both locals and tourist which offering a wide variety of goods and foods. It's a great place to experience local cultural, enjoy delicious food and shop for fresh ingredients. Continue to **[The Icon Siam Shopping Mall]** which is one of Bangkok's most iconic and luxurious shopping malls, often referred to as the "Mother of All Malls" due to its vast size and extravagant design.

Day 4: Honey Product Outlet ~ Soi Pratu Nokying the river view point ~ Across the river with metro boat to Wat Arun Temple ~ OrTohKor Premium Thai Fruits Market ~ Platinum Shopping Plaza ~ ASIATIQUE The Riverfront Night Market

After breakfast, proceed to **[Soi Pratu Nokying]**, a new IG spot attraction. Next, we will experience by taking ferry to the opposite river pier and continue to **[Wat Arun Temple]**, named after the God of Dawn (Aruna) and in honour of the literal and symbolic founding of a new Ayutthaya. After lunch, shopping stop at **[Or Toh Kor Famous Fruits Market]** and **[Platinum Shopping Plaza]**. Continue to **[ASIATIQUE the Riverfront Night Market]** mega open-air mall with river view and "festival market" concept.
