Day 1: Singapore → Chiang Rai – Akha Farm Ville – Mae Kha Jarn Hot Spring – Chiang Mai – Akha Ama Coffee (include 1 soft drink) – Three Kings Monument – Wat Chedi Luang Varaviharn – Night Market

Akha Farm Ville - this farm specializes in the Corriedale sheep breed and is surrounded by picturesque hills. The refreshing and cool climate offers wide-ranging vistas, with herds of sheep joyfully roaming the grassy fields. You can engage with the sheep, accompanied by friendly strong eyed dogs. Additionally, a café crafted from natural materials and adorned with local designs provides a serene space to savor beverages amidst nature's beauty.

Day 2: Chiang Mai Wat Phra That Doi Suthep Temple – Ban Kang Wat Artist Village – Wat U-Mong Temple – Chiang Mai Handy Craft & Umbrella Factory – Gem Gallery – Royal Park Ratchapruet (Included Tram cart ride) – Night Market

Chiang Mai Wat Phra That Doi Suthep Temple - the most sacred temple in Chiang Mai. Built in the early 19th Buddhist century, the temple is renowned for its exquisite Lanna architecture and the Chiang Saen-style golden pagoda enshrining sacred relics of the Lord Buddha. The grand staircase leading to the temple is beautifully adorned with seven-headed serpent (Naga) statues, creating an impressive and spiritual approach to this revered site.

Day 3: Chiang Mai – Lampang City – Retro Railway Station since A.D.1915 – Horse Cart Ride sightseeing the city – Wat Phrathat Lampang Luang Temple – Porcelain tile factory, Rooster brand – Chiang Rai (est around 3 hours journey) – Chiang Rai Night Plaza

Horse Cart Ride sightseeing the city - Enjoy a nostalgic Horse Cart Ride to explore the city — Lampang is the only province in Thailand that still offers traditional horse-drawn wagons, a favourite experience for visitors to enjoy the old-town scenery at a leisurely pace.

Day 4: Chiang Rai – Blue Temple – Wat Rong Sue Ten – Baan Dam Museum – Long Neck Karen Village – Choui Fong Tea Plantation – Doi Tung the summer Palace – Doi Wao Glass Sky Walk & Thai-Myanmar boarder market – Opium Museum – Golden Triangle View Point – Chiang Rai Night Plaza

Choui Fong Tea Plantation - one of Chiang Rai's most scenic tea farms, where you can stroll among lush green terraces, enjoy a cup of freshly brewed tea, and take in panoramic mountain views.

Doi Tung the summer Palace - the former summer residence of the Princess Mother, surrounded by beautifully landscaped gardens and lush forest.

Doi Wao Glass Sky Walk & Thai-Myanmar boarder market - Doi Wao Glass Sky Walk offering breathtaking views over the Mekong River and the Thai-Myanmar border, before browsing the nearby border market for local products.

Day 5: Chiang Rai – White Temple Wat Rong Khun – Singha Park Plantation (included tram cart sightseeing around the field) – Wat Phra Kaew Temple – Tea-break at Lalita café – Thai traditional massage (include 1hour)

Lalita café - A charming riverside café surrounded by lush greenery and vibrant flower gardens. Enjoy a relaxing break with aromatic coffee, refreshing beverages, and delightful desserts while soaking in the tranquil, photogenic atmosphere — perfect for a short rest and memorable photos.

Singha Park Plantation - A vast eco-tourism destination in Chiang Rai, renowned for its scenic tea plantations and high-quality agricultural products. The park features flower fields, a swan lake, a mini zoo, and zip line activities, along with several restaurants and cafés — offering a perfect blend of nature, recreation, and local flavour.

Day 6: Chiang Rai – Karen Ruammit Village & Elephant camp – Melt In Your Mouth Café – Big C Supercenter – Chiang Rai Airport → Singapore

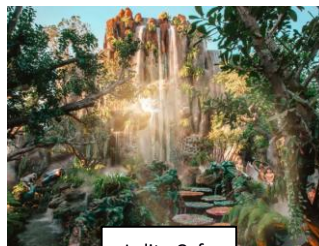
