Day 01: Singapore → Hanoi - the ancient capital city of Vietnam.

Day 03: * Halong Bay Cruise - Queen Cable car (enjoy a bird's eye view of Halong Bay) - Zen Garden - Koi bridges - Samurai race – Grand Sunwheel (Asia highest wheel)

Starting your day early to catch the sunrise over the serene beauty of Ha Long Bay is a fantastic idea. It's such a breathtaking sight, with the sun casting its golden hues over the thousands of limestone islands dotting the bay. Day 04: Literature temple - Sword Lake – Ngoc Son temple - Water Puppet Show (special national spectacle of Vietnam)

Start your day by visiting the Temple of Literature, which is not only a religious site but also Vietnam's first national university. This well-preserved complex is a testament to Vietnam's rich scholarly traditions and Confucian heritage. After immersing yourself in history and academia, take a leisurely stroll to Hoan Kiem Lake, also known as Sword Lake, located right in the heart of Hanoi. This picturesque lake is surrounded by lush greenery and is a popular spot for locals and tourists alike to relax and enjoy the scenery. Connected to the lake by the iconic red bridge, Ngoc Son Temple is a small but beautiful temple situated on a tiny island in the northern part of Hoan Kiem Lake. Dedicated to the national hero Tran Hung Dao, this temple offers stunning views of the lake and its surroundings. In the evening, experience one of Vietnam's most beloved cultural traditions - the Water Puppet Show. This unique art form originated in the rice fields of the Red River Delta and involves intricately carved puppets performing on water accompanied by traditional music and storytelling. It's a mesmerizing spectacle that offers insight into Vietnamese folklore and traditions.

Day 05: Thang Long Imperial Citadel – Grand church – Grand Opera House → Singapore
