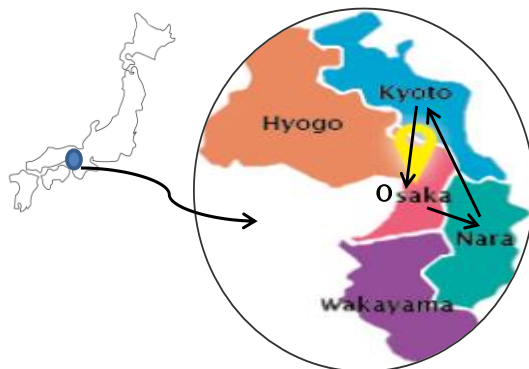

Day 2 Nara Todaiji – Todaiji is one of the most famous and historically significant temples in Japan, and it is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. **Deer Park** – is known for its friendly deer. These deer are considered sacred and roam freely in the park. You can enjoy feeding and interacting with them (*feeding is own expenses*). It's indeed one of the must-see areas when exploring Nara City in Japan.

Day 3 Arashiyama Bamboo – You can enjoy a serene and immersive experience in the bamboo grove, appreciating the natural beauty and tranquillity of this iconic Japanese landscape. **Tenryu-ji Temple** is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of Kyoto's most important Zen temples. It offers a beautiful garden with scenic views of the surrounding mountains. **Nishiki Market** is a lively and historic food market in the heart of Kyoto, Japan. It's offering a diverse array of fresh and local food products. **Kiyomizu-dera** is a famous Buddhist temple in Kyoto, Japan, known for its wooden terrace that offers stunning panoramic views of the city. You may experience to dress in Kimono while exploring the historic and picturesque surroundings of Kiyomizu-dera.

Day 4 Fushimi Inari - is an iconic Shinto shrine located in Fushimi-ku, Kyoto, Japan. **Amanohashidate View Land** is a popular viewpoint and recreational facility located in Miyazu City. Amanohashidate itself is a scenic sandbar that spans the mouth of Miyazu Bay, and it is considered one of the "Three Views of Japan," known for its breathtaking beauty. **Amanohashidate Cruise** - You can have a cruise experience around Amanohashidate to enjoy the landscape from the sea and observe seabirds flying close to the boat. **Kasamatsu Park** - an observatory where you can overlook Amanohashidate.

Day 5 *Biwako – enjoy the seasonal fruit picking fun. **Omiachiman Hachimanhori** - is known for its preserved Edo-period (1603–1868) merchant houses, traditional architecture, and charming atmosphere. **La Collina Omihachiman** - a fairy-tale-like building surrounded by natural charm, offering delectable desserts. **Mitsui outlet** - is a chain of outlet shopping malls in Japan operated by the Mitsui Fudosan Group.

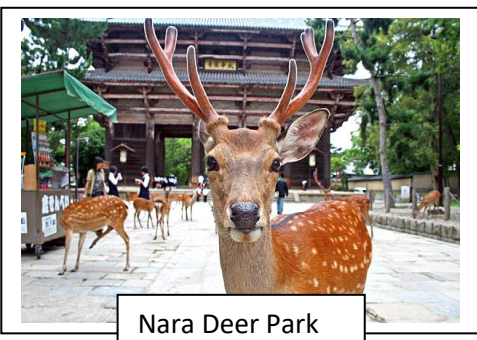
Day 6 Kobe Chinatown – can enjoy not only the authentic Chinese cuisine but also the cultural ambiance, events, and architectural charm of this historic district. **Kobe Kitano Ijinkan** - known for its well-preserved Western-style houses from the Meiji and Taisho eras. **Umeda Sky building** - is a prominent landmark and skyscraper located in the Umeda district of Osaka, Japan.

Day 7 Kuromon market - The market is known for its diverse range of shops and stalls offering fresh produce, seafood, meat, street food, snacks, and a wide array of culinary delights. **Ikeda Nishin cup noodle museum** – the birthplace of instant noodles. You can experience and design your own cup noodle at here. **Osaka castle** - is one of Japan's most famous and historically significant castles. **Dotonbori** - is a lively and iconic district in Osaka. **Shinsaibashi Shopping Arcade** - offers an extensive range of shops, boutiques, and department stores.
