DAY 1 Singapore → Fukuoka

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport for your flight to the "Land of the Rising Sun" - Japan.

DAY 2 Fukuoka - Saga

Begin the day with **Daizaifu**. After that experience a relaxing **Yanagawa boat ride**, gliding through scenic canals lined with charming riverside views. Continue to the impressive **Yutoku Inari Shrine**, one of Japan's most beautiful Shinto shrines, known for its striking red architecture set against lush hillsides.

DAY 3 Nagasaki - Kumamoto

This morning, visit the solemn **Nagasaki Peace Park** and the **Atomic Bomb Museum**, where you will gain a deeper understanding of the city's tragic past and enduring message of peace. Continue with an outer view of the historic **Oura Church**, Japan's oldest surviving Christian church and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, before proceeding to Kumamoto.

DAY 4 Kumamoto - Miyazaki - ASO

Board a **car ferry** and enjoy the unique experience of **feeding seagulls** as you sail. Upon arrival, visit the iconic **Kumamoto Castle**, one of Japan's most celebrated castles, admired for its striking architecture and rich history. Continue to the scenic Takachiho Gorge, where you can marvel at the breathtaking **Takachiho Waterfall**, cascading dramatically into the river below.

DAY 5 ASO - Oita

Travel to **Daikanbo**, a scenic lookout point offering sweeping views of Mt. Aso's volcanic caldera. Continue to the colourful **Kuju Flower Park**, where seasonal blooms create a picturesque landscape. Walk across the impressive **Kuju Suspension Bridge**, one of the highest pedestrian suspension bridges in

Japan, for panoramic mountain views. End the day with a unique relaxation experience at **hot sand bath**, where warm natural sand soothes and refreshes the body.

DAY 6 Oita

Begin the day in Beppu, famous for its hot springs. Visit the impressive **Umi Jigoku (Sea Hell)**, with its cobalt-blue steaming pond. Continue to the charming **Yufuin town**, a picturesque hot spring resort nestled against scenic mountains, where you can stroll along quaint streets filled with cafes, boutiques, and art galleries. In the afternoon, head to **Mojiko Retro District**, a nostalgic port town featuring beautifully preserved Western-style architecture from the early 20th century.

DAY 7 Kitakyushu

Explore Kokura, beginning with a visit to the historic **Kokura Castle (outer view)**, surrounded by beautiful gardens and offering insights into the region's samurai past. Continue to a lively **wet market**, where you can experience the local food culture and discover fresh seafood and regional specialties. End the day with shopping at the **Kitakyushu Outlet**, featuring a wide selection of local and international brands at great value.

DAY 8 Fukuoka Free & Easy

Spend the day at leisure in Fukuoka. Explore bustling shopping districts, savor local specialties such as Hakata ramen, or simply relax and soak in the vibrant atmosphere of this lively port city before your departure.

DAY 9 Fukuoka → Singapore

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight back to Singapore, bringing home unforgettable memories of your Kyushu journey.
