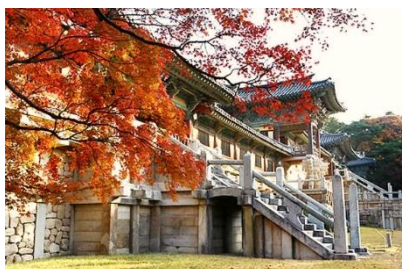
## Gaehangjang Street

Incheon Port was opened in 1883. Feel the rich history & culture accumulated over 126 years. Formerly used by the Japanese consulate, the Jung-gu Office, the Incheon branch of Japan's 1st, 18th and 58th Bank and other modern historical architecture can be found intact here.



## Gamcheon Cultural Village

## Bulguksa Temple

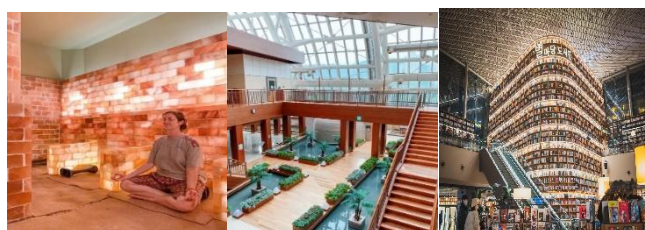
