CLUBD OASIS Ocean View Jjimjilbang

Haedong Yonggungsa Temple

Located on the east coast of Busan and is the only temple in Korea built on seaside. The temple was founded in 1376 during the reign of King Goryeo. Its geographical location near mountains and rivers makes the temple look elegant yet unique. It houses the Sea Goddess of Mercy, and a three-story stone pagoda with four lions etc.



Haeundae Coastal Train

Located on the east coast of Busan, with a total length of 4.8 kilometers, the Haeundae Sightseeing Train runs on the most beautiful coastline in the country. Enjoy the romantic beauty of Busan's east coast..



Gaya Theme Park + Hanbok Experience

Explore Gaya Historical Story Hall: Gaya Palace Hall and Queen Hall; Gaya Culture Exhibition Hall: Japanese Pavilion and Indian Pavilion. Experience the history through games, activities, exhibitions, etc. Enjoy the Painter's show (based Gaya Kingdom) uses scratching, painting and other techniques to combine lighting, music and dance to present wonderful performances ". In the Four Seasons Garden, you can see tulips in full bloom during the cherry blossom season. Dressed up in Hanbok and explore the park.



Pohang SPACE WALK

Korea's "walking roller coaster" Pohang's new landmark "Space Walk" is 333m long and has a total 717 steps. The highest point of the walk is about 25m above ground. When walking on the track, you will feel like travelling on space and with a 360-degree zero-dead-spot view, you can enjoy scenery of Pohang and the beautiful sunset.

Day 3: Guryongpo Japanese House (filming location of K-Drama: When the Camellia Blooms) ~ **Homigot Lighthouse, Hand of Harmony** ~ **Pohang Jukdo Market** (the largest seafood market on the east coast) ~ **Pohang SPACE WALK** (walking roller coaster)

Day 4: FE01 Steel Art Village (IG Hotspot) ~ **Haeundae Romantic Coastal Train** (enjoy the beautiful coastal scenery of East Busan) ~ **Cheongsapo Daritdol Observatory** (20m high glass-bottomed sea view skywalk) ~ **CLUB'D OASIS Haeundae Sea View Jjimjilbang** ~ **International Market** (Nampo-dong, Gwangbok-dong, BIFF International Movie Plaza)
