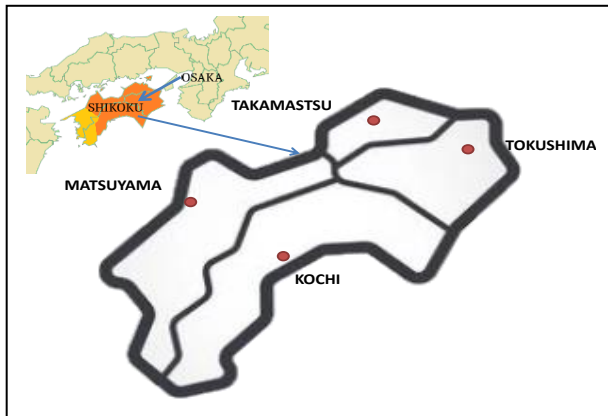

Day 1 Singapore → Osaka

Day 2 Awaji Island – Akashi Kaikyo Bridge – Awaji Kaikyo Park

Day 6 Tokushima – Vine Bridge in the Iya Valley – Naruto Whirlpools – Awaodori Kaikan – Bizan Ropeway

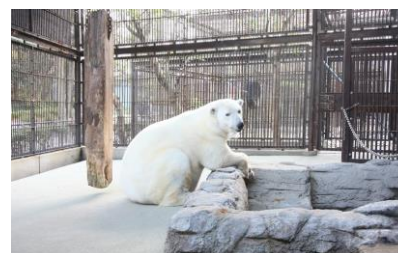
