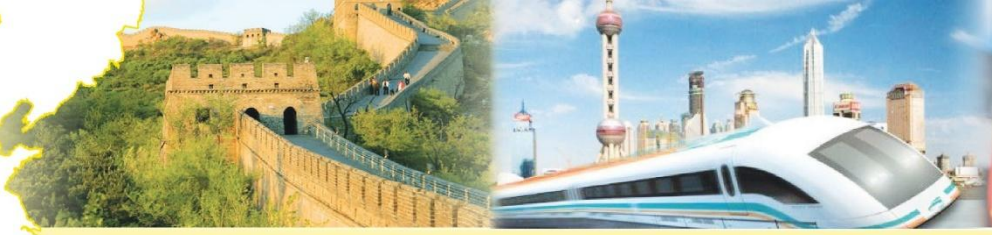

Lake Baikal @ Siberia

Surrounded by jagged mountains and taiga of pine, fir and cedar, it is the world's most voluminous lake. Its mirror-clear water are a reflection of Siberia's wildness, its vastness and its beauty. In Summer, enjoy gobsmacking vistas across waters of the deepest blue to soaring mountain ranges on the opposite shore



Olkhon Island

The 4th-largest lake-bound island in the world and the largest island in Lake Baikal. The untouched Siberian forests, craggy capes, pristine beaches and jaw-dropping sunsets, steep capes with unusual shapes make it a place to treasure

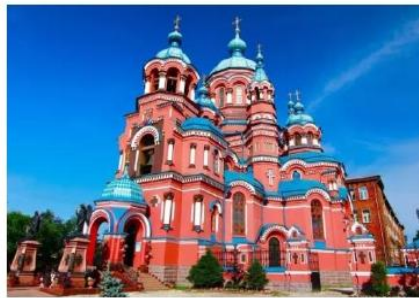


Khoboy Cape

It is the northernmost point of Olkhon Island where the Small Sea meets the waters of Great Baikal. From the earliest times it was considered to be a sacred place and served for performing religious rites

Irkutsk Kazan Church

With Byzantine style decorations, it looks like a fairy tower. It is known for the Irkutsk's largest church bell. The inner spaces are decorated with fresco paintings. A unique iconostasis is carved out the Indian granite by Chinese craftsmen.



Listvyanka Village

Originally a C19th fishing village, A large number of the traditional wooden izba village houses still survive in the village. An urban locality (a work settlement), near the point where the Angara River leaves Lake Baikal.



Trans-Siberian Railway

enjoy a typical day on the Trans-Siberian Railway. Your private train passes through endless scenery of forests, lakes and small settlements. A day to relax, watch the landscape and listen to lectures about the country and its people.

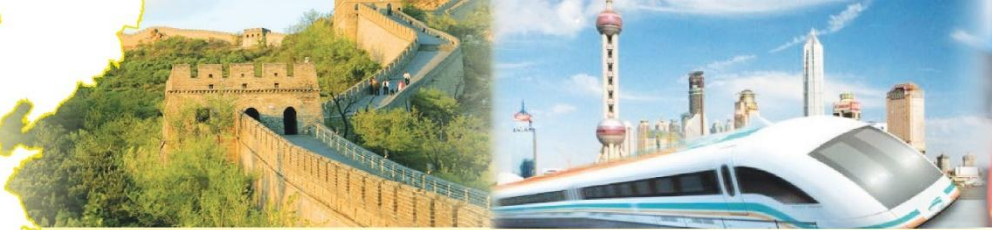

Day 1 Singapore✱ Hailar

Day 2 Hailar ~ (est. 1hr) Hulunbuir Grassland~ Nadam Fair~ (Est 2.5hrs) Manzhouli ~ Matryoshka Doll Thematic Square <outlook>~ Night City Coach Tour

Coach to Hulunbuir Grassland. Upon arrival, you will enjoy a special Mongolian welcome ceremony where you will drink local wine and offered traditional ceremonial scarfs called khata. Experience a **Nadam Fair** which features ethnic Mongolian traditional nomadic sports and entertainment, including wrestling and archery. In addition to the traditional sporting events, you may also enjoy folk singing, dancing and other activities during the fairs.

Take a glance at **Matryoshka Doll Thematic Square** the only one of its kind in China featuring very authentic and diversified Russian souvenirs and crafts. One of matryoshka doll is 30 meters tall, the biggest in the world.

Day 3 Manzhouli~ (est. 32hrs train) Irkutsk <Train 353: 14.00pm-Next Day 22.56pm>

Drive to the Manzhouli Port, pass the border inspection, next to the Russian port and pass the Russian border inspection. After that take a train at **Zabaykalsk Railway Station** to Irkutsk, begin your journey to Lake Baikal.

<Pls note that the train schedule is subject to the local final arrangement. If above train is not available, the conversion train will be arranged.>

Day 4 Trans-Siberian Railway~Irkutsk

Trans-Siberian is not just a railway, it's an experience, a comfortable and even amazing setting. Today along the picturesque railway, Lake Baikal just next, meeting Russian villages along the way. It's a great stop for you to explore the Eastern Siberia.

Day 5 Irkutsk ~ Irkutsk City Tour ~ (est. 4hrs) Olkhon Island Incl. Ferry Service

Irkutsk City Tour Go around the center of Irkutsk, with stops at a variety interesting points, You'll see churches, historical monuments, the houses of famous merchants and patrons of arts, museums, theaters, plazas and squares.

Olkhon Island the largest island of Lake Baikal and the world's third largest "lake-bound" island.

Day 6 Olkhon Island~ Sagaan-Khushun Cape~ Khoboy Cape Incl. Russian Military Jeep

Depart by Russian military jeeps to explore Olkhon Island and classic Lake Baikal vistas. Heading north and make stops at Sagaan-Khushun Cape, coastal sand dunes and stretches of beach along the way, including the 600'-high cliffs of Khoboy Cape at the northern tip of the island. En-tour enjoying a picnic lunch.

Khoboy Cape would be replaced by **Southern tip of the island to enjoy a view of Sunset when it is a bad weather, subj to land agent final arrangement**

Day 7 Olkhon Island~The Pier Incl. Ferry Service~ (est. 5hrs) Irkutsk~ 130 Kvartal ~ Karla Marksa Street ~ Kazan Church

Drive to the ferry-station and coach to Irkutsk with a total travelling time around 5-6hrs.

130 Kvartal: A pleasant place to stroll, packed with restaurants, cafes and commercial museums, and culminating in Eastern Siberia's only real 21st-century shopping mall

Karla Marksa Street: The main street in the old town of Irkutsk, with shops and cafes

Day 8 Irkutsk ~ Taltsy Museum~ (est. 1hr) Listvyanka Village~ Baikal Limnological Museum ~ ~City Tour ~Irkutsk ✱ Singapore

Taltsy Museum: looks like an ancient village with long streets, wooden houses, water mills and even a small school; 40 landmarked buildings and 8000 artifacts dated by XVII-XIX centuries are presented as part of the exhibition. The wooden buildings brought from all over Siberia.

Baikal Limnological Museum: All exhibits are dedicated to the origin and the history of the lake, Models of the lake bed showing its history, the peculiarities of its shoreline and bottom. Since 2004 a living exhibition started at the museum in 11 aquariums.
