## 1 Singapore → Haneda / Narita

Assemble at Changi Airport for your flight to the "Land of the Rising Sun" - Japan.

## 2 Tokyo → Aomori ~ Nebuta museum "Warrase" ~ Seafood Market

**Nebuta museum "Warrase":** offers an immersive experience into the festival's history, artistry, and traditions. **Seafood Market:** A fish market special for "Nokkeidon" where you can buy and make local delicious by choose different fish (sashimi).

## 3 Aomori ~ Hirosaki Castle ~ Oirase Stream ~ Lake Towada ~ Aniai Station to Matsuba Station (\*Local Train Experience)

**Hirosaki Castle:** is widely considered to be one of Japan's most beautiful castles. The Castle ground is now a public park famous for its Cherry Blossom in Spring. **Oirase Stream:** is a mountain stream flow from Lake Towada in Aomori of 14km. One of the best sceneries of Japan Tohoku region (especially in Autumn). **Lake Towada** is a famous volcanic lake located in the Tohoku region of Japan, straddling both Aomori and Akita Prefectures. It was formed by a volcanic eruption that created a caldera, and it is renowned for its clear waters and breathtaking natural scenery.

## 4 Hanamaki ~ Chuson-ji Temple ~ Matsushima Bay Cruise ~ "Kamaboko" Fish Cake (DIY) ~ Sendai Godaido ~ Kanran-tei ~ Aoba Ave

**Chuson-ji Temple:** a UNESCO World Heritage site, its collections which represent the pinnacle of valuable peaceful Buddhist art in Eastern Japan. **Kamaboko (DIY):** Kamaboko is a type of cured surimi. We do the BBQ for this local "kamaboko". **Kanran-tei** is a must-visit attraction where you can experience traditional Japanese tea ceremony while enjoying the beautiful scenery of Matsushima. **Aoba Ave:** is a beautiful tree lined Main Street that runs in the heart of Sendai City.

## 5 Sendai Morning Market~ Fruit Picking ~ Ginzan Onsen Old Town ~ Yamagata

**Fruit Picking:** (Dec-May \*Strawberry /Jun-Jul \*Cherry /Aug \*Peach / Sep-Nov \*Apple). **Ginzan Onsen Old Town:** Ginzan Onsen is a picturesque hot spring town nestled in the mountains of Yamagata Prefecture, Japan. Renowned for its nostalgic ambiance, the town features traditional ryokan (inns) lining the Ginzan River, illuminated by gas lamps, creating a scene reminiscent of Studio Ghibli's Spirited Away.

## 6 Yamagata~ \*Mt. Zao "Snow Monster" (Ropeway) (\*Bonus: Dec - Mar) ~ \*Volcano "Okama" (\*Nov-Apr replaced by Rairaiyko Gorge) ~ \*Goshikinuma (Five colour Pond) (Dec-Mar replaced by Zao Fox Village) ~ Lake Inawashiro

**\*Mt. Zao "Snow Monster" (Ropeway):** it attracted lots of ski enthusiasts and ice-capped trees become "Snow Monsters". This is a rare sight in Japan. **Volcano Lake "Okama":** Active volcano features a beautiful crater with lake, due to its resemblance with a traditional cooking pot. **Goshikinuma:** The eruption imparted mineral deposits to the Five Colored Pond giving different color according to the sun light direction ranging from reddish green to cobalt blue. **Lake Inawashiro:** is the fourth-largest lake in Japan, located in central Fukushima. It is also known as the "Heavenly Mirror Lake".

## 7 Inawashiro ~ Sake Brewery ~ Akabeko (DIY) ~ Ouchijyuku ~ Kinugawa

**Akabeko (DIY):** It is a local "Red Cow's Puppet Toy" of the Aizu region. Boko is a dialect means "Cattle". DIY to colour paint and draw your own design pattern on this red cow puppet. **Ouchijyuku:** This village was established under the post station system of the Edo period, and played a vital role as a rest stop for travellers. It is famous for the numerous traditional thatched buildings from the Edo Period that lines its main street.

## 8 Kinugawa - \*Nikko : Irohazaka Road ~

### \*Lake Chuzenjiko ~ \*Kegon Waterfall ~ Nikko Toshogu → Singapore

**Irohazaka Road:** has a total of 48 turns. Well-known for its autumnal sights and it's also the filming location for "Initial D" movie. **Nikko Toshogu:** It is a magnificent memorial to shogunate "Tokugawa Ieyasu". The lavishly decorated shrine complex consists of more than a dozen buildings set in a beautiful forest. Transfer to the airport for your flight back to Singapore

**\*Winter (Dec - Mar): \*Nikko tour replaced by Nikko Toshogu ~ Outlets Mall → Singapore**
