Day 1 SINGAPORE ✈️ VANCOUVER

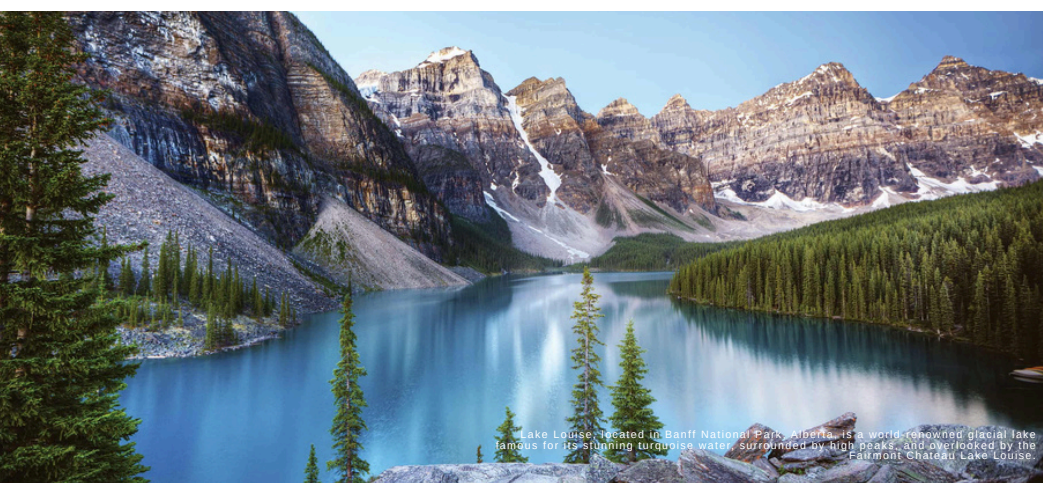
Upon your arrival in **Vancouver**, transfer from YVR Airport to hotel. Take some time to settle into your accommodation and relax after your flight.

Day 2 VANCOUVER - HOPE - KELOWNA (B/L/D)

After breakfast, make our way to **Hope Town**, a picturesque area embraced by forested mountains, where you'll find streets adorned with chainsaw wood carvings crafted by local artists. Next, continue your journey to **Kelowna**, located in the heart of the Okanagan Valley, Canada's premier wine region. Don't miss the chance to visit a local award-winning **winery**, where you can partake in a complimentary tasting of ice wine, made from naturally frozen Vidal grapes harvested at temperatures of -8°C or lower.

Day 3 KELOWNA - REVELSTOKE - LAKE LOUISE - BANFF (B/L/D)

Start your day at **The Last Spike** in **Revelstoke**, a monument marking the final railway spike driven in 1885, completing the Canadian Pacific Railway. Then, visit **Emerald Lake**, celebrated for its vibrant emerald hue and stunning natural reflections. Explore Natural Bridge, a rock formation carved by glacier meltwater over thousands of years. Head to **Lake Louise**, the "Blue Diamond of the Rockies," with its turquoise waters reflecting Victoria Glacier. At **Bow Falls**, admire the roaring whitewater against an alpine backdrop, featured in the Marilyn Monroe film *"River of No Return"* (1954). Conclude in **Banff Town**, known as Little Switzerland, with its charming mountain village atmosphere.



Lake Louise is located in Banff National Park, Alberta. It is a world-renowned glacial lake famous for its stunning turquoise water, surrounded by high peaks, and overlooked by the Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise.

Day12 GLACIER BAY NATIONAL PARK(SCENIC CRUISING) (B/L/D)

Today's highlight is **Glacier Bay National Park**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the most spectacular natural reserves in the world. Spanning over 13,000 square kilometers, this icy wonderland was shaped by glaciers that began retreating just over 200 years ago, revealing a dramatic landscape of towering tidewater glaciers, snowy mountain ranges, and deep fjords. Cruise slowly through the Margerie Glacier and Lamplugh Glacier, where if lucky, you may witness ice calving—huge chunks of ice breaking off and crashing into the sea with a thunderous roar. Keep a lookout for sea otters, harbor seals, bald eagles, and sometimes even humpback whales gliding through the icy waters.

No docking today—just pure front-row seats to Alaska's untouched wilderness from the comfort of your cruise ship.

Day13 COLLEGE FJORD, ALASKA (SCENIC CRUISING) (B/L/D)

Experience the breathtaking **College Fjord** in northern Prince William Sound. This area boasts five tidewater glaciers, five large valley glaciers, and many hanging glaciers, named after Ivy League schools like Harvard, Yale, and Dartmouth. Marvel at ice walls plunging into frigid waters, surrounded by snow-capped mountains and vibrant forests. College Fjord was charted during the Harriman Expedition of 1899 and is a highlight of Alaska cruising, offering a chance to spot harbor seals on ice floes. Enjoy unparalleled views from your cruise ship without docking.

Day14 ANCHORAGE ✈️ SEATTLE (B/D)

After disembarking in **Whittier**, transfer to Anchorage Airport for your flight to **Seattle**. Upon arrival, visit **Pike Place Market** to explore the stalls, watch the fish toss, and enjoy the atmosphere, then walk down to the **Seattle Waterfront** and stroll along the piers for views of **Elliott Bay**. Finish with a stop at **Kerry Park** for a free, iconic view of the Seattle skyline and Mount Rainier before heading back to hotel.

Day15 SEATTLE ✈️ SINGAPORE (B)

After checking out of the hotel, enjoy some leisure time at **Seattle Premium Outlets**, where you can shop for premium brands in a stylish open-air setting. Later, transfer to the airport for your flight home, bringing with your wonderful memories of an unforgettable journey.

Day 4 BANFF - ICEFIELD - BANFF (B/D)

Travel along the picturesque **Icefields Parkway**, renowned as one of the world's most breathtaking highways. Make a stop at **Bow Lake**, a glacier-fed alpine lake with crystal-clear reflections of the surrounding peaks—the source of the Bow River. Continue to the iconic **Columbia Icefield**, one of the largest icefields in North America. Hop aboard the **Ice Explorer** (in season), a massive snow vehicle specially designed to drive onto the glacier. Ride across ancient ice formed over 10,000 years ago and experience the breathtaking frozen landscape. Enjoy lunch at your own expense at the Icefield Centre with glacier views.

Day 5 BANFF - KAMLOOPS (B/L)

Embark on a journey through the stunning **Rogers Pass**, the sole route through the Columbia Mountains, renowned for its steep terrain and remarkable snowfall—over 70 feet during winter, making it one of Canada's snowiest locations. Stop in **Kamloops**, a sunny city situated at the confluence of the North and South Thompson Rivers, celebrated for its breathtaking natural beauty and arid hills. Visit the **Ginseng Factory**, where you will discover how this region became one of North America's largest producers of ginseng, and savor a tasting of its health-enhancing herbal teas.

Day 6 KAMLOOPS - VANCOUVER (B)

After breakfast, embark on a drive to **Vancouver** for an exciting city tour. First, stop at **Queen Elizabeth Park**, the highest point in the city, which provides breathtaking panoramic views of the skyline and surrounding mountains—a perfect spot for capturing memorable photos. Next, head to **Granville Island**, where you can explore an indoor market brimming with fresh produce, gourmet foods, handmade crafts, and unique gifts created by local artisans. You'll find yourself enchanted by Vancouver's unique blend of natural beauty and vibrant urban life.

Day 7 VANCOUVER - BOARD CRUISE (B/DIM SUM L/D)

Explore **Chinatown**, the second largest in North America, rich with over a century of cultural heritage. Take a leisurely walk through **Gastown**, the birthplace of Vancouver since 1886, where you can marvel at the world's first Steam Clock, still releasing steam to signal the hour. Don't miss **Stanley Park - Totem Park**, featuring an impressive array of Indigenous totem poles, one of the most photographed sites in British Columbia. Finally, make your way to the **Canada Place Cruise Terminal** to board your cruise. Settle into your cabin and enjoy your first night on the open sea.

Day 8 AT SEA (SCENIC CRUISING) (B/L/D)

Sail through the breathtaking Alaska Inside Passage, a legendary coastal route filled with forest-lined islands, glacial fjords, and snow-capped peaks. Keep watch for whales, seals, and bald eagles as you enjoy a relaxing day aboard with panoramic sea views.

Day 9 KETCHIKAN, ALASKA (B/L/D)

Arrive in **Ketchikan**, often referred to as the "Salmon Capital of the World." Stroll along **Creek Street**, a charming historic boardwalk that stretches over a creek teeming with salmon. Immerse yourself in the town's vibrant Tlingit Native culture and admire the iconic totem poles that tell its rich history.

Day10 JUNEAU, ALASKA (B/L/D)

Dock in **Juneau**, the secluded capital of Alaska, beautifully situated between glacier-capped mountains and the serene Gastineau Channel. Stroll through downtown, where you can discover handcrafted totem art, seal oil soaps, and shimmering nuggets.

Day11 SKAGWAY, ALASKA (B/L/D)

Arrive in **Skagway**, a charming town steeped in gold rush history, which thrived as dreamers sought their fortunes back in 1898. Take a leisurely walk along Broadway Street, where vibrant wooden saloons, heritage shops, and frontier-style buildings await you—it's like stepping into the Wild West.



Seattle, the largest city in Washington, is affectionately referred to as "The Emerald City" due to its abundant greenery. It is home to significant tech giants like Amazon and Microsoft, as well as the iconic Space Needle. The city boasts a lively music scene, particularly famous for its grunge roots, and is renowned for its exceptional coffee culture.

FEB 26 DAW

Day 1 新加坡 ✈️ 温哥华

于樟宜国际机场集合，搭乘班机飞往加拿大**温哥华**。抵达后，专车接送前往酒店休息。

Day 2 温哥华 – 霍普镇 – 基洛纳 (早/午/晚餐)

早餐后，前往被群山环抱的**霍普镇**，这里的街道两旁陈列着由当地艺术家精心雕刻的木雕艺术品，充满了浓厚的手工艺气息。随后前往位于加拿大奥肯那根谷核心的**基洛纳**，这是加拿大著名的葡萄酒产区。参观当地**获奖酒庄**，还能**品尝冰酒**——这种珍贵的甜酒由在零下 8°C 或更低温度下自然冰冻的葡萄酿制而成，口感独特、回味悠长。

Day 3 基洛纳 – 雷夫尔斯托克 – 路易斯湖– 班夫小镇 (早/午/晚餐)

出发**雷夫尔斯托克**的**最后一钉纪念碑**，是加拿大太平洋铁路全线贯通，浓缩了19世纪铁路建设的辉煌岁月。随后前往**翡翠湖**，湖水因清澈的翡翠色泽和宁静的自然倒影而闻名，是摄影与静心漫步的绝佳胜地。沿途探访**天然桥**，这座由冰川融水经千年雕琢而成的岩石奇观，展现大自然的鬼斧神工。接着，抵达**路易斯湖**——落基山脉的“蓝色钻石”，是游客必打卡的经典景点。随后**弓河瀑布**，湍急的白水奔腾而下，映衬高山背景。行程的终点是**班夫小镇**，这座被誉为“小瑞士”的山地小镇，以迷人的街区景致和悠闲的村落氛围，为一天画上完美句号。



Day 4 班夫小镇 – 哥伦比亚冰原 – 班夫小镇 (早/晚餐)

沿着风景如画的**冰原大道**前行，这条被誉为世界上最壮丽的公路之一，将落基山脉的巍峨峰峦与宁静高山湖泊尽收眼底。途经**弓湖**，这座由冰川融水形成的高山湖泊以清澈见底的湖水映照周围雪峰而闻名，同时也是弓河的源头。继续前往标志性的**哥伦比亚冰原**，在冰原开放季节，可登上**冰原探险车**，这是一种专为冰川地形设计的巨型雪地车辆，缓缓驶过形成于一万多年前的古老冰层，让人零距离感受震撼的冰雪奇观。午餐自费于****冰原中心****享用，同时俯瞰周围壮丽的冰川景致，为这段高山探险增添独特体验。

Day 5 班夫小镇 – 坎卢普斯 (早/午餐)

踏上穿越壮丽的**罗杰斯隘口**之旅，这里是横穿哥伦比亚山脉的唯一通道，以陡峭的地形和惊人的降雪量而闻名——冬季降雪量超过70英尺。随后前往**坎卢普斯**，这座阳光充沛的城市位于北汤普森河与南汤普森河的交汇处，以迷人的自然风光和干燥起伏的丘陵而著称。参观**人参工厂**，了解该地区如何发展成为北美最大的人参产区之一，并品尝有益健康的人参茶。



Day 6 坎卢普斯 – 温哥华 (早)

早餐后，驱车前往**温哥华**，开启一段精彩的城市之旅。首先前往**伊丽莎白女王公园**，这里是温哥华的最高点，可俯瞰城市天际线与周围群山的壮丽全景，是拍照留念的绝佳地点。随后前往**格兰维尔岛**，探索热闹非凡的室内市场，这里汇集了新鲜农产品、美食佳肴、手工艺品，以及当地艺术家精心打造的独特纪念品。温哥华将自然之美与活力四射的都市生活完美融合，定会令您流连忘返。

Day 7 温哥华 – 登船 (早/粤式点心/晚餐)

探索北美第二大的**唐人街**，感受其拥有百余年历史的深厚文化底蕴。随后悠闲漫步于**盖士镇**，这里自1886年起便是温哥华的发源地，可欣赏世界上第一座**蒸汽钟**，至今仍会喷出蒸汽报时。接着前往**史丹利公园**——**图腾公园**，欣赏气势非凡的原住民图腾柱群，这是不列颠哥伦比亚省最常被拍摄的景点之一。最后前往**加拿大广场邮轮码头**办理登船手续，登上邮轮后安顿于您的客舱，在辽阔海上迎来旅程的第一晚。

Day 8 阿拉斯加 (内弯风景巡航) (早/午/晚餐)

航行于令人叹为观止的阿拉斯加内湾航道，一条传奇性的海岸航线，沿途遍布林木葱郁的岛屿、冰川峡湾和白雪覆盖的群峰。可在船上悠闲度过一天，欣赏开阔的海景，同时留意鲸鱼、海豹以及白头海雕等野生动物的身影。

Day 9 凯奇坎, 阿拉斯加州 (早/午/晚餐)

抵达**凯奇坎**，这座城市常被誉为“世界鲑鱼之都”。漫步于**溪街**，这是一条横跨鲑鱼成群溪流之上的迷人历史木栈道。深入体验当地充满活力的特林吉特原住民文化，欣赏讲述其悠久历史的标志性图腾柱。



Day10 朱诺, 阿拉斯加州 (早/午/晚餐)

停靠于阿拉斯加州首府**朱诺**，这座与世隔绝的城市坐落在覆满冰川的群山与宁静的加斯蒂诺海峡之间，景色秀丽迷人。漫步于市中心，可发现精美的手工图腾艺术品、以海豹油制成的香皂，以及闪闪发光的金块纪念品。

Day11 斯卡圭, 阿拉斯加州 (早/午/晚餐)

抵达**斯卡圭**，这座迷人的小镇深深浸润着淘金热时期的历史气息，早在1898年，无数逐梦者在此追逐财富。悠闲漫步于百老汇大街，色彩鲜艳的木质酒馆、历史悠久的商店以及充满边疆风格的建筑映入眼帘，仿佛一步踏入狂野的西部年代。



Day12 冰川湾国家公园 (内弯风景巡航) (早/午/晚餐)

今天的亮点是**冰川湾国家公园**，这是一处联合国教科文组织世界遗产，也是世界上最壮观的自然保护区之一。公园面积超过13,000平方公里，这片冰雪奇境由冰川塑造而成，而这些冰川在200多年前开始退缩，展现出雄伟的潮水冰川、雪山和深邃峡湾的壮丽景观。慢慢巡航穿过马杰里冰川和兰普卢冰川，若运气好，您可能会目睹冰块崩裂入海，伴随雷鸣般的巨响。请留意海獭、港海豹、白头海雕，有时甚至还能看到座头鲸在冰冷海水中优雅滑翔。

今天无靠岸——只需舒适地坐在邮轮上，便可享受阿拉斯加原始荒野的最佳观景区。

Day13 学院峡湾 (内弯风景巡航) (早/午/晚餐)

体验位于威廉王子湾北部的壮丽**学院峡湾**。这里汇聚了五条潮水冰川、五条大型山谷冰川以及众多悬挂冰川，冰川以常春藤联盟大学如哈佛、耶鲁和达特茅斯命名。冰墙直坠入寒冷海水，四周环绕着雪山和郁郁葱葱的森林，景色令人叹为观止。学院峡湾由1899年的哈里曼探险队绘制，是阿拉斯加邮轮旅程中的一大亮点，您还有机会在浮冰上看到港海豹。无需靠岸，即可从邮轮上尽享无与伦比的景观。

Day14 安克雷奇 ✈️ 西雅图 (早/晚餐)

下船抵达**惠蒂尔**后，前往**安克雷奇**机场搭乘航班飞往**西雅图**。抵达后，游览**派克市场**，逛摊位、观赏抛鱼表演，感受热闹的市场氛围。随后前往**西雅图海滨**，沿码头漫步，欣赏**艾略特湾**的美景。最后前往**凯瑞公园**，从观景点俯瞰标志性的西雅图天际线及雷尼尔山，随后返回酒店。

Day15 西雅图 ✈️ 新加坡 (早餐)

退房后，前往**西雅图**名品**奥特莱斯**享受自由购物时光，在别致的露天环境中选购各类高端品牌商品。随后前往机场搭乘返程航班，带着这段难忘旅程的美好回忆回家。
