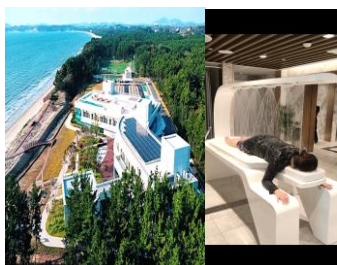
Asan Oeom Folk Village

The main filming location for the K-Drama "Missing: The Other Side 2". It boasts a history spanning over 500 years. This agricultural village is a clan village, home to the Yi family hailing from Yean. The village was designated as National Folk Cultural Heritage.



Boeun Beopjusa Temple

Built in 553 during the 14th year of Silla King Jinheung's reign, it is located on Songnisan Mountain. However, many of the original buildings were destroyed during the Imjin War (1592-1598), with the current structures having been rebuilt in 1624. The temple features many beautiful and important Buddhist relics and artworks, centered around the main hall, Daeungbojeon Hall.



Tae'an Marine Healing center

Experience a range of therapies, including peat far-infrared treatment, peat wrapping and scrub, as well as cypress healing sessions. It is a wellness complex that harnesses natural marine resources such as seawater, peat, and salt to promote relaxation and rejuvenation. Featuring hydrotherapy pools, spa and therapy rooms,.



Suwon Hwaseong Fortress

Hwaseong Fortress was designated UNESCO World Cultural Heritage in 1997 due to its historical value. There are performances every day, and the Suwon Hwaseong Culture Festival is held every autumn. The city wall stretches for 5,700km. The castle was built from 1794 to 1796 by King Jeongjo to honour the remains of his father, Prince Sado.



Yesan Yedangho Monorail

The Yedangho Monorail is a popular mountaintop railcar located in Yesan. It offers a scenic 22-minute ride looping around Yedangho Lake, showcasing changing nature scenery and the famous suspension bridge. The 402-meter-long Yedangho Suspension Bridge is the longest suspension bridge in Korea.
