J Dolphin & Seal Cruise @ Walvis Bay

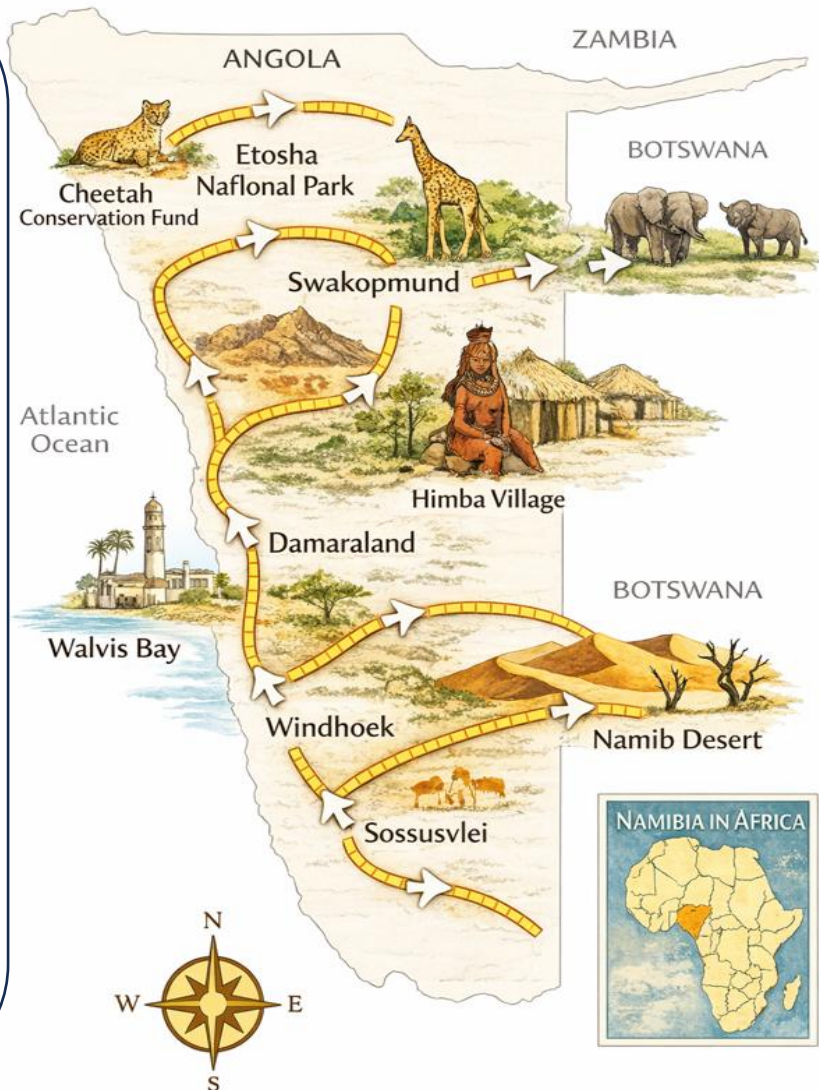
Enjoy fresh Walvis Bay oysters, sparkling wine, a light lunch and drinks on board while watching the playful seals, aquatic birds and dolphins.

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1 Singapore ✈ Windhoek

#Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport for your flight to **Windhoek** - the capital of Namibia.

2 Windhoek ~ City Tour

- + **[Christuskirche]** Iconic German-style Lutheran church
- + **[Independence Memorial Museum]** a landmark history museum ,
The viewing platform offering extensive views over Windhoek.

3 Windhoek ~Etosha National Park ~ Cheetah Conservation Fund

- + **[Etosha National Park]** It is known as Namibia's foremost wildlife sanctuary. The landscape is unique and varied and subsequently home to a wide variety of animals. For example lion, elephant, leopard, giraffe, cheetah, hyena, springbok, two kinds of zebra, eland and many more species of wildlife are found here.
- + **[Cheetah Conservation Fund]** It operates a world-class research and education centre focused on mitigating human-wildlife conflict and protecting the world's largest wild cheetah population.

**Etosha National Park -Morning Game Drive****4 ~Twyfelfontein -Bushman Rock Engravings
《UNESCO》 ~Himba village**

- + **[Etosha National Park-Morning Game Drive]** It typically start at sunrise, focusing on active predators, rhinos, and diverse plains game gathering at waterholes. Guided in open-sided vehicles, it offers excellent photography opportunities in cool, soft light.
- + **[Twyfelfontein-Bushman Rock Engravings]** a UNESCO World Heritage Site,home to one of Africa's largest concentrations of ancient rock engravings. It features over 2,500 petroglyphs and approximately 200 rock paintings, One of the most famous carvings, depicting a lion with a long, kinked tail ending in a human hand,
- + **[Himba Village]** Visit a traditional Himba village and experience their unique lifestyle and strong connection to nature. Observe women applying ochre and making jewelry, showcasing beauty and cultural identity.

**5 Twyfelfontein ~Swakopmund ~Lighthouse
~Mole Waterfront ~Local Market**

- + **[Swakopmund]** A coastal city with German architecture, providing a base for adventure before venturing into Namib Desert.
- + **[Lighthouse]** an iconic and beautiful landmark close to the town center, It serves as a prominent landmark and active maritime beacon guiding ships, the light can be seen more than 33 km out to sea.
- + **[Mole Waterfront]** Originally built as a breakwater by German colonial engineers in 1899, it eventually silted up, creating the sandy beach area enjoyed today.

6 Swakopmund ~Walvis Bay Incl a scenic dolphin & seal cruise ~Dune 7

- + **[Walvis Bay]** is Namibia's second-largest city and its only deep-water port, Nestled between the Atlantic Ocean and the towering dunes of the Namib Desert.
- + **[A scenic dolphin and seal cruise]** offers sightings of Cape fur seals and frequent encounters with dolphins. Habituated seals and pelicans often hop onto the boats for close-up interaction and feeding by the crew. During the excursion, enjoy a light lunch featuring fresh Namibian oysters and sparkling wine.
- + **[Dune 7]** the tallest sand dune in the area, ideal for climbing, photography, and viewing the surrounding coastal desert scenery.

**7 Swakopmund ~Free Day**

- # Today may explore Swakopmund at your own leisure, stroll the German-style old town, enjoy the Atlantic sunset along the promenade, or try fresh oysters at a seafood restaurant.
- + **[Half-day Sandwich Harbour 4x4 excursion -Optional]** Witness the towering dunes of Namib Desert meeting the Atlantic Ocean.

8 Swakopmund ~Namib Desert ~Sossusvlei

- + **[Namib Desert]** With its red dunes rolling endlessly into the ocean, It is the oldest desert in the world-a sea of silica stretching along Namibia's entire Atlantic coast.

**9 Sossusvlei National Park - Dune 45 - Deadvlei
- Sesriem Canyon**

- + **[Sossusvlei]** located within the Namib-Naukluft National Park, is one of Namibia's most iconic attractions, known for its towering red sand dunes and stark white clay pans.
- + **[Dune 45]** One of the area's most iconic and photogenic dunes, Its elegant curves and dramatic light-and-shadow effects make it a photographer's paradise, especially at sunrise and sunset when the colors and textures are most vivid.
- + **[Deadvlei]** A white clay pan surrounded by some of the world's tallest red dunes; one of the most otherworldly landscapes on Earth. The contrast of white salt flats, blackened dead trees, deep red dunes, and blue sky makes it a dream destination for photographers.
- + **[Sesriem Canyon]** Known for its red sandstone formations and occasional pools of water, it offers a striking rocky landscape that contrasts with the surrounding red dunes.

**10 Sossusvlei ~Windhoek**

#Farewell with Sossusvlei, On the return journey to Windhoek, enjoy a scenic drive through the Namib-Naukluft Desert, featuring dramatic mountain landscapes, desert wildlife.
